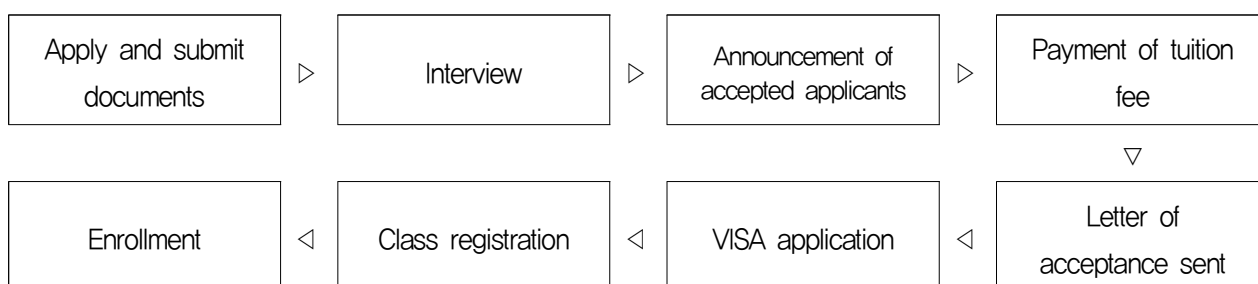

- In the case of arts and sports colleges, practical screening and portfolio can be submitted.
- In some departments (e.g. Design School), additional semesters may be taken depending on the credits earned for major subjects and graduation project completion requirements.

- The Department of Architecture aims to nurture architectural design professionals (architects) and accredits from the Accreditation Board for Architectural Education (5-year course)
- Departments participating in the Engineering Education Accreditation System (track): Department of Electrical Engineering, Department of Chemical Engineering, Department of Architectural Civil Engineering (Architectural Engineering Track), Department of Environmental Engineering, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Department of Future Automotive.
- The Department of International Studies and the Department of International Industry–Academic Convergence are designated exclusively for international students.

- ※ For the Department of International Studies (excluding the English Track), there is no Korean language proficiency requirement for admission; however, students are required to take designated Korean language courses offered by the department after enrollment.

- ※ Completion of qualification examinations and programs such as GED, home schooling, online courses, or language schools, etc, from the level of primary, secondary to higher education are not regarded as equivalent to a regular academic school curriculum.
- ※ Students who are sponsored by the government, such as GKS students, will be selected with particular conditions.

II. Precautions

- ※ In case of sister universities, some of the above documents may be omitted, and additional documents may be requested in addition to the above documents for the qualification examination of applicants, and no documents submitted are returned.
- ※ All submitted documents **must be original**. In case of submitting photocopied documents, applicants must have the copies **notarized or submitted with apostille**. Translation notarization issued by China Notary Office is required to submit a double translation notarization(双号翻译公证件).
- ※ Documents written in other languages(not in Kor/Eng) have to submitted together with translated notary.
- ※ All submitted documents shall not be returned (Immune to any situation).
- ※ If some documents are incomplete or you have submitted a certificate of expected graduation (completion), you must submit a certificate of graduation before admission. Failure to submit it may result in your admission being cancelled.
- ※ Applicants who graduated from a Korean high school may receive a deduction in evaluation scores depending on the number of school violence disciplinary actions recorded.
