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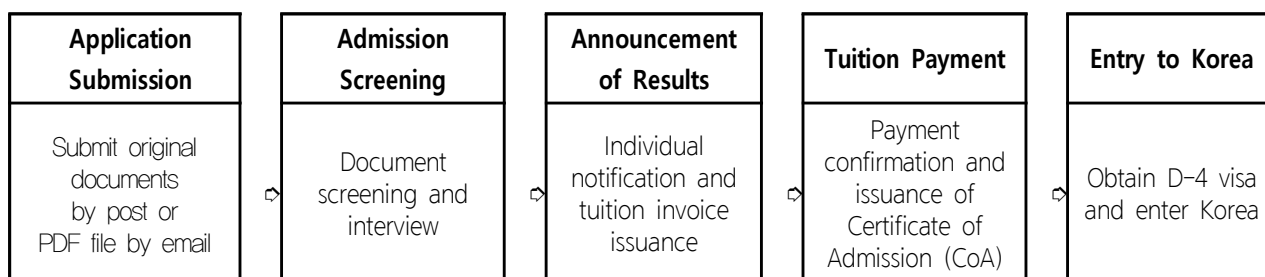

Eligibility

- Applicants whose native language is **not Korean**
- Applicants who are high school graduates or possess an equivalent educational qualification
- Eligibility may vary depending on individual circumstances; applicants are advised to contact the admissions office for further clarifications.

Application Submission Procedure

- Applications may be submitted by mail (original documents) or by email (PDF file). Applications submitted through mail must submit the original documents before entering Korea. Admission may be revoked if submitted PDF copies differ from the original documents.

Admissions Review Period

- The document review process approximately takes 1–2 weeks. Applicants may be requested additional documents if materials are incomplete.
- The results will be announced within one week of the interview, and successful applicants will receive a the tuition Invoice.
- The Certificate of Admission will be issued within 2–3 days after tuition payment is processed.
- If you do not receive a response within the specific time-frame, please contact the admissions office.

Visa Information

- Students who have received a Letter of Admission must apply for the Language Training Visa (D-4-1) at the Korean embassy or consulate in their country of residence. The document requirement (such as a letter of admission, a letter of guarantee, and proof of financial support) vary by country, so kindly re-check in advance.
- Although the processing time for visa issuance varies by country, it typically takes more than one month, so applicants are advised to begin visa procedures at least two months before the start of the semester. The D-4-1 visa is generally issued for six months and will assist you with visa extension at the Korean Immigration Office upon arrival in Korea.

Airport Pick-Up Service

- Successful applicants will receive an email containing the pickup schedule for Incheon Airport Terminals 1 and 2, and the URL to upload their flight tickets. Please be sure to review this information carefully and use it as a reference when booking your flight. The airport pickup service is typically provided one week before the start of the semester.
- Students traveling independently must also inform us their arrival schedule and travel plans..
- Students arriving outside the designated pickup schedule may still be eligible for pickup depending on the number of participants, so do inquire in advance.

Upon Arrival

- Students must visit the International Cooperation Team (Room 101, Kang Seok-gyu Education Building) upon arrival.
- Support will be provide information on Korean Language Program orientation, class assignment, alien registration card application, bank account opening, Dormitory accommodations, etc.

- Please bring your passport, passport-size photo, house contract, etc when visiting the International Cooperation Team.
- We recommend joining social media platforms such as KakaoTalk or WeChat to facilitate smooth communication and to stay updated on announcements.

Dormitory Information

- Affordable on-campus housing is available for international students. Dormitory life provides opportunities for intercultural exchange and community building.
- Students planning to live in the dormitory must notify the university after receiving your acceptance letters.

Health Insurance

- Upon arriving in Korea, all Korean language students must enroll in the insurance plan offered by the university. The insurance premium is approximately 70,000 to 110,000 won (per year, varying by the student's age).
- Six months after arrival, students are automatically enrolled in the National Health Insurance, the same coverage as Korean citizens. The insurance premium is approximately 70,000 to 80,000 won (per month, varying by the student's age).

Enrollment Cancellation

- If enrollment is canceled before the start of the program, or if you are unable to enter Korea due to visa rejection or other related reasons, the full tuition amount will be refunded excluding the application processing fee (100,000 KRW).
- If you withdraw after entering Korea and after the program has begun, refunds will be issued in accordance with the Korean Language Center's tuition refund policy.
 - Before one-third of the semester: Two-third of tuition fee
 - After one-third but before first half of the semester: Half of the tuition fee
 - After the first half of the semester: No refund.
- To cancel enrollment, please contact the admissions office.
